

Cooling Tower Notification

Any person, who has, to any extent, control of premises has a duty to ensure that any notifiable device situated on the premises is notified in writing by approved form to the local authority in whose area the premises are situated.

A notifiable device means a cooling tower or an evaporative condenser except:

- a) Where it contains no water that is exposed to air and
- b) where the water supply is not connected and
- c) where it's electrical supply is not connected.

A cooling tower is a device whose main purpose is to cool water by direct contact between that water and a stream of air. An evaporative condenser is a device whose main purpose is to cool a fluid by passing that fluid through a heat exchanger which is itself cooled by contact with water passing through a stream of air.

The notification form should be completed and returned to Environmental Services. There is no fee payable.
