We are writing to object strongly to the proposed building of 280 more houses, Policy SAMU5, Development South of Thorpe Road, Weeley.


We understand this would require the demolition of the Council Offices at a time when there are so many more people moving into the area anyway with extra houses already going up along the Clacton Road, the development in Weeley Heath, the Little Clacton proposal and also Kirby Cross, not to mention the extra caravans for the Starena Lodge endeavouring to be passed.

We do not have the road structure for all the extra cars this development will generate, nor doctor surgeries and school places for the people moving into the area. St. Andrews School has already been extended a few times and I believe has nowhere else to add classrooms except into the playing field and with so many children living in surrounding villages the volume of cars delivering them is already having problems finding parking and stopping places in the morning and afternoon.

This is an agricultural area not an industrial one and I understand some of the work places in Clacton are already standing empty and not generating work. This would mean that all the extra people moving into the area have to travel to Colchester, Ipswich or London thereby generating even more traffic on our already inadequate roads.

We therefore do NOT agree with the development of this lovely agricultural hill for more houses.
