I see that the Proposed Modifications are out for consultation and the deadline is 31 August 2021,

I understand the attached SOCG that was submitted to the council by Stewart. A particular issue is an area of protected open space at Ardleigh Reservoir was been mistakenly identified on the Proposals Map by the Council. I believe that the Council agreed to remove it in the SOCG. The area in question is the small green area east of the word Bois on the map below. This is taken from the maps shown for consultation.

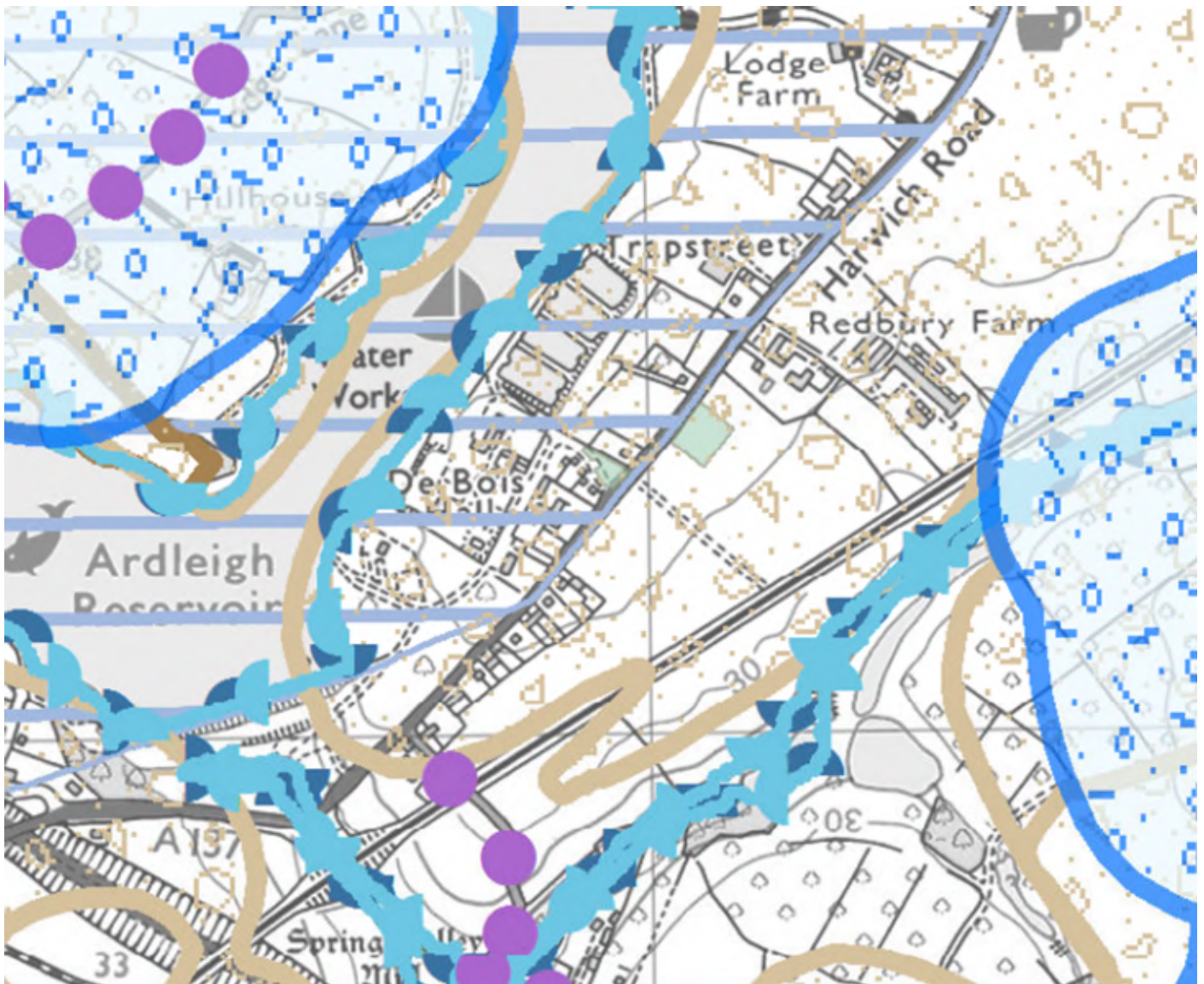
